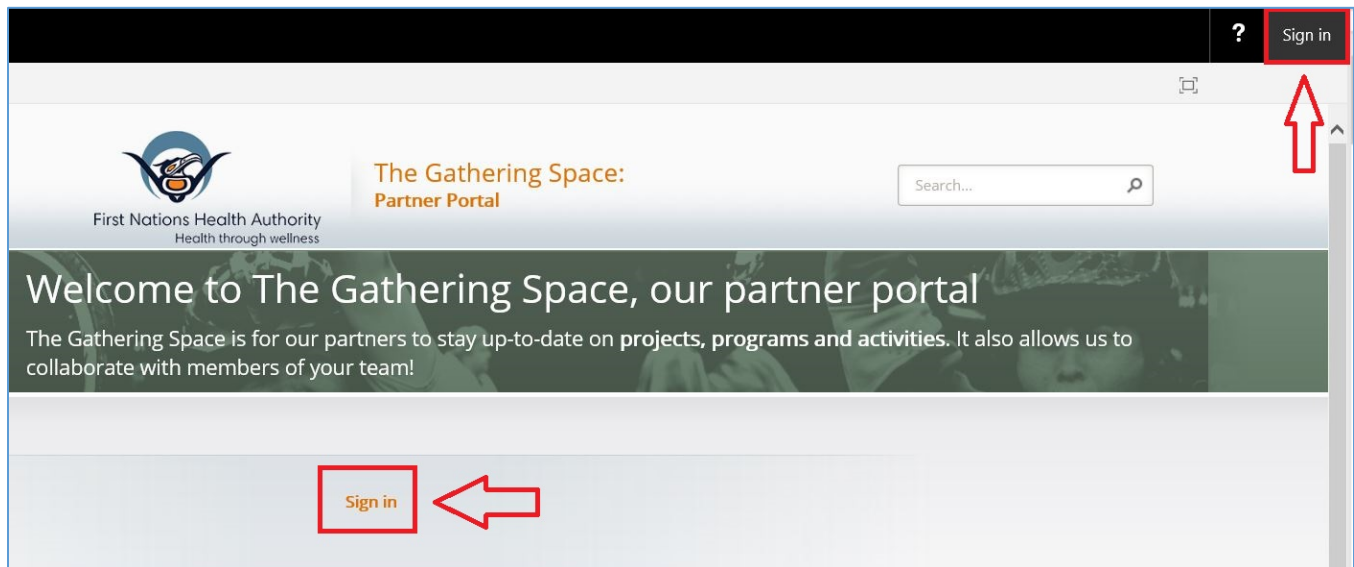

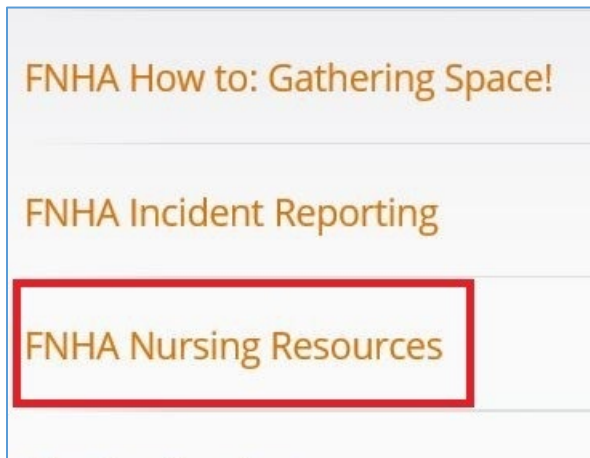

To Change Password or Forgotten Password – What To Do

- Account passwords expire every **90 days**. To reset a password or If you have forgotten your old password, call external FNHA Service Desk toll-free phone line: **1-833-693-6900** to reset a password
- It may take a couple of days to issue you a new password
 - The FNHA Service Desk hours are Monday to Friday 8am to 5pm
- For resetting the password, you would have to answer security questions that you set up when you access the site for the first time
- After the password reset, you will be given a new password
- If you don't remember answers to security questions, contact Jessica Chien (jessica.chien@fnha.ca) to create a service ticket to arrange a new password and security questions reset
