# Pharmacy Care Initiative Grant

**Grants are available until December 31, 2024 – apply now!**

**Did you know that grants are available to support First Nations communities and organizations with pharmacy-related initiatives?**

## **What is a Pharmacy Care Initiative Grant?**

Grant funding can be used to host events or improve processes that facilitate and support pharmacy related initiatives such as:

- Shingrix Vaccination;
- Access to over-the-counter medication;
- Smoking cessation therapy;
- Resolving coverage issues;
- Prescription delivery process;
- Access to clinical pharmacy services (i.e. medication reviews);
- Enhancing wrap-around care for community Opioid Antagonist Therapy (OAT) programming;
- Initiatives that build relationships between community members and Pharmacists; or
- Other pharmacy service priorities identified by the applicant.



## **Who is eligible for the grants?**

First Nations communities and First Nations organizations that are engaged in direct health service delivery to First Nations people in British Columbia (BC).

## **When are applications open?**

Applications are open from April 1- December 31, 2024. You can learn more about grant eligibility and how to apply by visiting the link or scanning the QR code below.
