Background






- Focus on approaches to healing and wholistic wellness
- Unresolved trauma and disenfranchised grief brought to forefront
- Compounding traumas and emergencies increased need for mental health and wellness supports
- TRC Call to Action 21#: Sustainable funding for existing and new Aboriginal healing centres

Healing Centres and Modalities



FNHA's Vision: Provincial network of healing centres and modalities as part of a comprehensive continuum of care



- In alignment with TRC Call to Action 21 sustainable funding for existing and new Aboriginal healing centres
- Complement, not replace, existing services along the continuum (e.g. treatment centres)
- Provide:
 - A place to connect people to healing, trauma specific services and wrap around supports.
 - Traditional healers working alongside trauma specialists towards creating a traditional healing & trauma-specific therapy
 - Integrated continuity of care



Site Selection



Region-led Process

- Phased approach last fiscal one site per region
- Phase 2: site selection is in various stages of completion
- Funding available to support hiring regional coordination leads

Work Underway

- 7 sites committed:
 - 1 Interior; 1 Vancouver Island; 2
 Vancouver Coastal; 3 Fraser Salish
- Implementation plan complete
- Rebuilding the Circle (housed at Kackaamin) is implementing their plan
 - Initiating mobile unit next fiscal
- 5 year implementation plan drafted

Next Steps

- Complete 2 more site selections for phase 2
- Pre-planning & Planning phases for second phase sites
- Support Implementation phase for other 1st phase sites
- Secure operational funds
